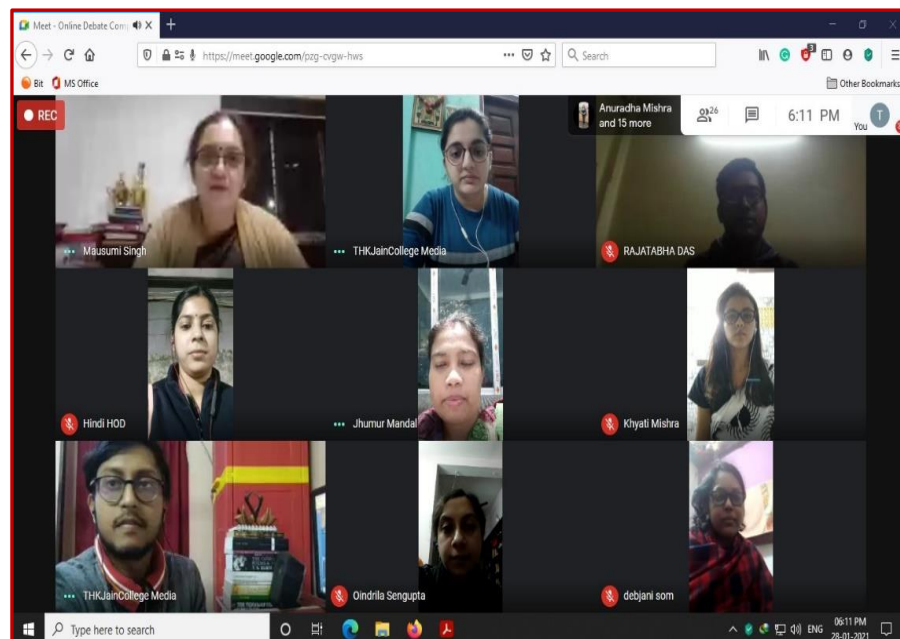
- PLASTIC POLLUTION:**

2. **Scammers:** Your email inbox is probably full of their work.

- **Extension activities for neighborhood community:**

In this time of distress, T.H.K Jain College, Kolkata came up with a humanitarian act to help the needy people to cope with the situation. The NSS Unit of the College started the initiative **“Food on Wheel”** program (distribution of food) for people from the nearby slum areas, from 24<sup>th</sup> May to 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.
