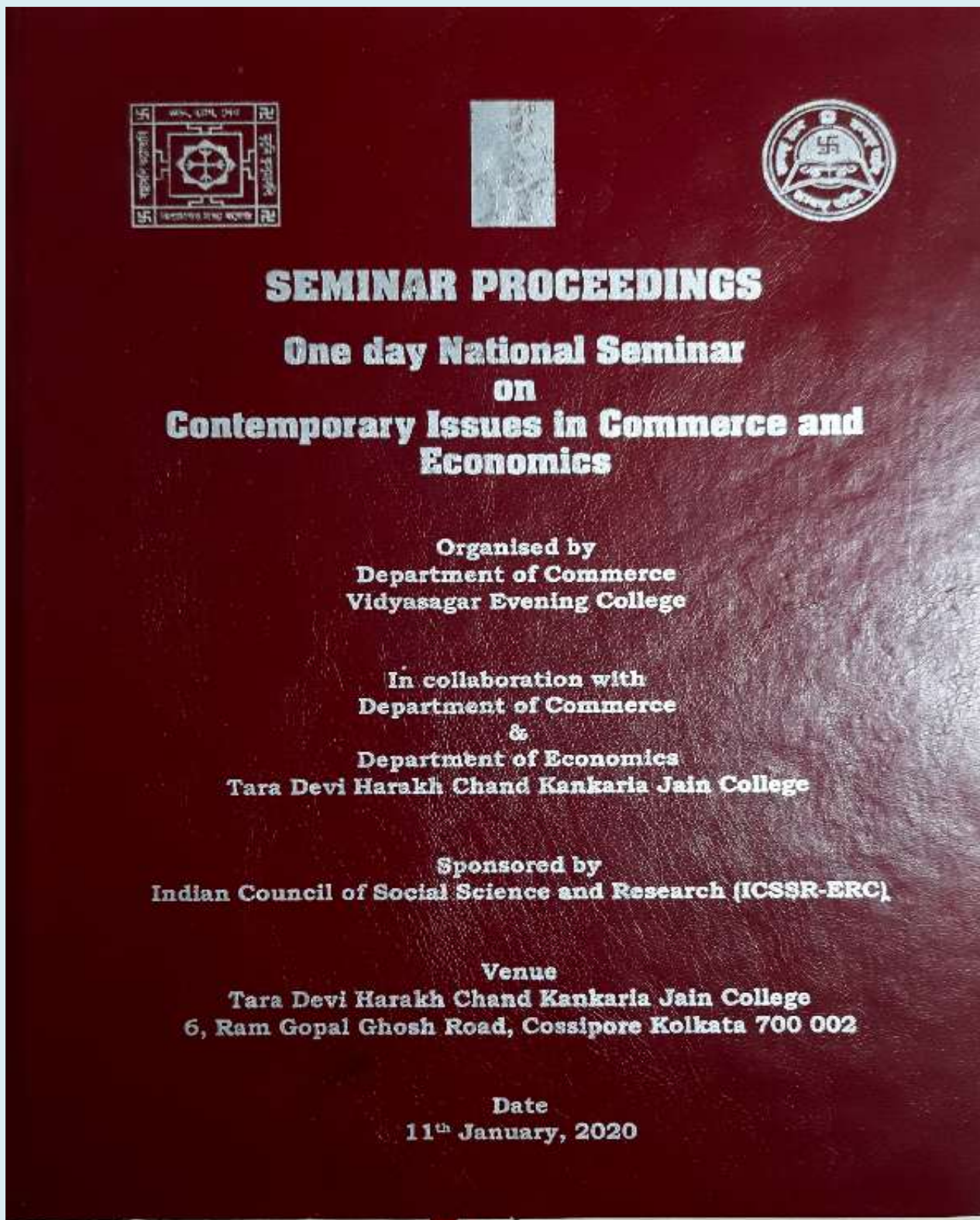
About Vidyasagar Evening College: The journey of Vidyasagar Evening College began when Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay became the President of the Managing Committee of the Calcutta Training School in 1858, and subsequently it paved the way for the establishment of Metropolitan Institution in 1900. In 1917 it was renamed Vidyasagar College. Subsequently its academic curriculum expanded with the Senior Division of the Commerce Department in 1922 and the Morning Section for Women in 1931. The Commerce Department of the College has the distinction of being the first non-Government night college teaching commerce in West Bengal. In 1929 the college was granted affiliation by the University of Calcutta. The evening section emerged as an independent entity with a separate Governing Body in 1961 bearing the name Vidyasagar Evening College (Incorporated by UDC acts 20th and 12th). With the recent construction of separate buildings for Vidyasagar Evening College and Vidyasagar College for Women (by the acquisition of a plot of land adjacent to the main building of the College), the institution is favourably poised for the fulfillment of quite a few of its plans. Today the College (accredited by NAAC) offers undergraduate courses with Honours in Commerce, Bengali, English, Political Science, Geography, Mathematics, Physics and Physiology.
