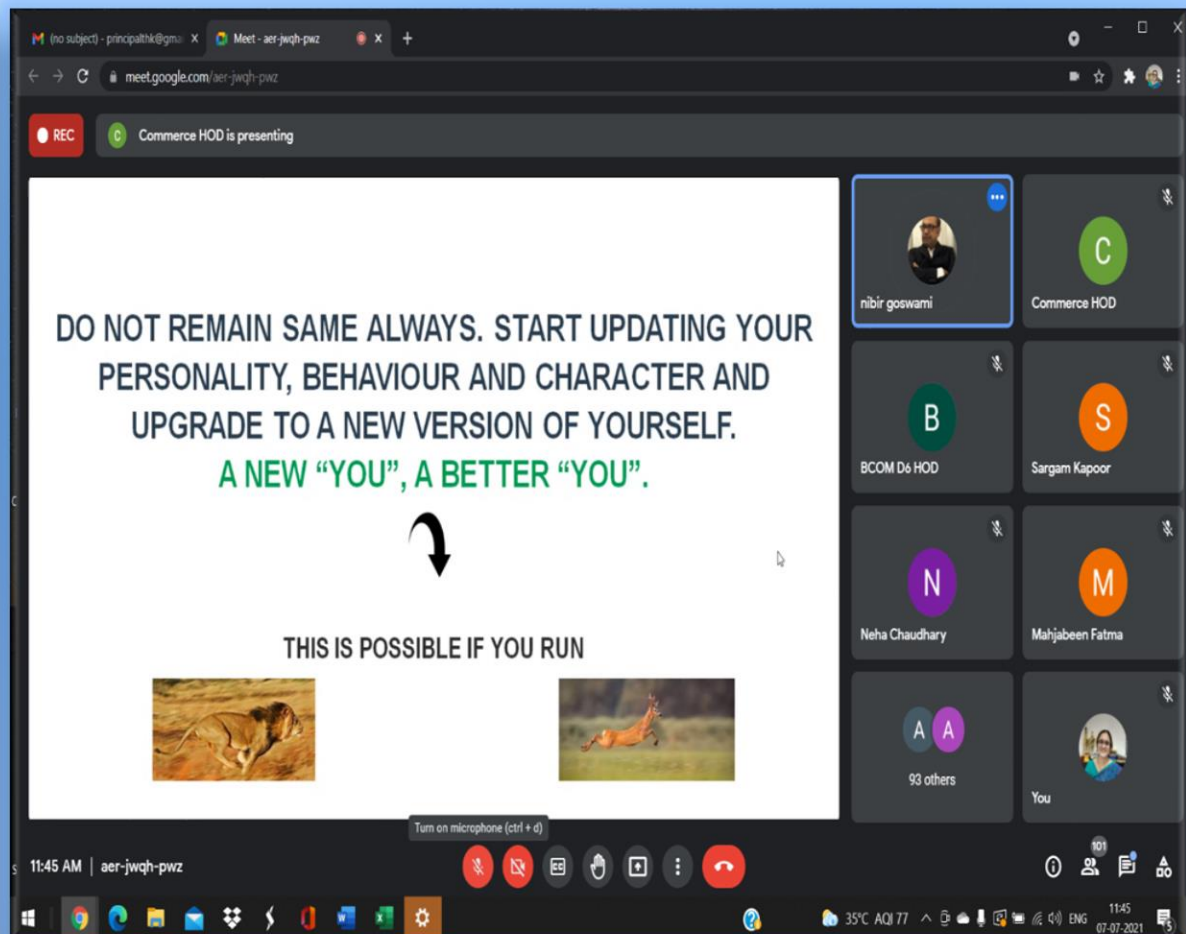

## Green Initiatives in the college

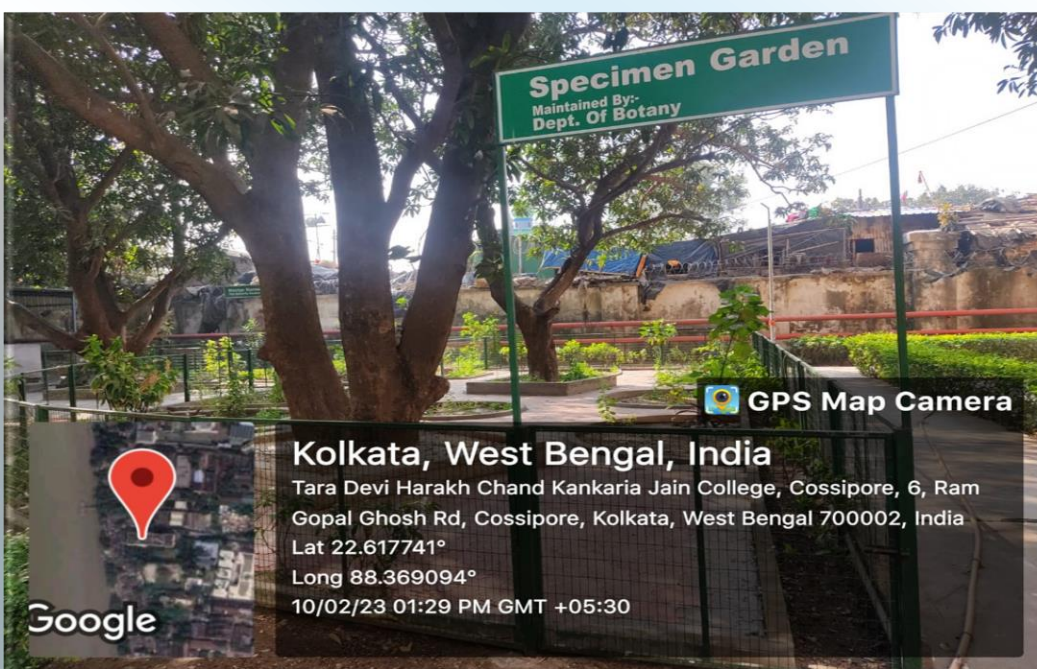
### • Green Manure Production

The college took initiative in production of green manure through composting method using waste products of kitchen and dried leaves of garden. The department of Botany oversees this unit. The inauguration event on 16<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2021 was graced by Prof. Samir Ranjan Sikdar (Retd. Professor, Bose Institute, Kolkata). The three tanks were opened by ribbon-cutting and first tank was filled up with dry leaves and collected kitchen waste. Water mixed with cow dung and Molasses solution was further added to it. Compost production started within 3 months and produced around 100 kgs of manure by end of 6 months; to be used for plantations and gardening purposes.

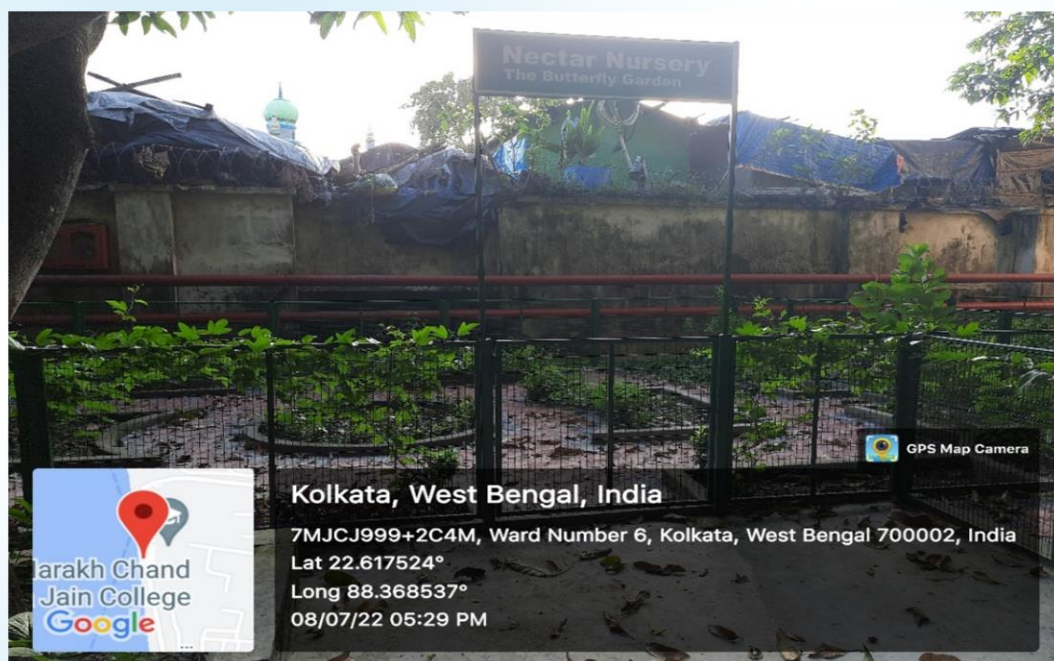
