**Following are the observations from the feedback:**

**Teachers:**

The syllabus is:

- Quite extensive and is difficult to complete the vast syllabus of some of the papers within the span available of each semester. A strategic planning needs to be done for effective completion of the courses
- More textbooks as per curriculum needs to be added in the library

**Alumni**

- The syllabus to be more job-oriented and helpful in qualifying state/national level entrance examinations at the PG level. The college must take initiative to arrange textbooks/organize classes which may benefit students for various state/national entrance examinations

**Students:**

The syllabus needs to be:

- More helpful in job employability and qualifying entrance level examinations after graduation
- There is enough scope of arranging student exchange, industry/field visit, internship opportunities for improving their skill. The college must take more initiatives to arrange all such visits as a part of effective experiential learning
- More flexibility in choice of subjects as per CBCS pattern
